"GLOBAL DAY OF INCLUSION" JULY 21, 2018

2018 marks the 50th Anniversary of the global Special Olympics movement, with the WHEREAS:

first International Special Olympics Games being held on 20 July 1968 at Soldier Field in

Chicago, Illinois, USA; and

WHEREAS: Special Olympics' vision for a more inclusive world has grown over 50 years to become a

global movement for change and social justice that uses sport, health, and education to

empower people with and without intellectual disabilities around the world; and

Special Olympics is the global leader - with more than 5 million participants in more WHEREAS:

> than 170 countries – in providing continuing opportunities through sports for people with intellectual disabilities to realize their potential, develop physical fitness,

demonstrate courage, and experience joy and friendship; and

Special Olympics builds communities of understanding, inclusion, and respect; and WHEREAS:

Special Olympics' goal for the next 50 years is to end discrimination against people with WHEREAS:

intellectual disabilities; and

WHEREAS: in July of 2018, Special Olympics will kick off a one-year 50th anniversary; and

Special Olympics is calling for people around the world to commit to making their WHEREAS:

communities more inclusive by joining in a "Global Day of Inclusion" on 21 July 2018.
