

## Hazardous Materials Summary Form

This form is to be completed and submitted in association with an application for a Building Permit where the proposed works include **demolition, alterations or renovations within an existing structure.**

The information provided here is intended to assist the Building Official in determining if a Hazardous Materials Assessment Report, in compliance with WorkSafeBC Guidelines Part 20, has been completed. If a Hazardous Materials Assessment Report has not been completed, the Building Official will request further information regarding the scope of the project and the presence of any potentially hazardous materials.

If deemed necessary, during a site inspection, the Building Official may ask that a report be produced. If a report prepared by a qualified person (as per WorkSafeBC Guidelines Part 20) cannot be produced, the Building Official may stop the inspection to ensure their safety.
