Westwood Lake reopens for swimming

The Vancouver Island Health Authority (VIHA) has informed the City of Nanaimo that the E.Coli count at Westwood Lake is now within the allowable limit and the lake is open for swimming. Results from water tests conducted by VIHA were provided to the City Wednesday afternoon.
