Maximum of 20 attendees per session. RSVP is required (cultureandheritage@nanaimo.ca). Spots are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

As well, they support the 2014-2020 Cultural Plan for a Creative Nanaimo's strategy to support ongoing and stable core funding to non-profit arts and cultural organizations to enable them to leverage funding from other sources.
