Drivers reminded of maximum on-street parking times

Parked vehicles must be moved after a period of 24 hours

Summary

The City of Nanaimo wishes to remind owners and operators of vehicles that on-street parking is limited to 24 hours before a vehicle must be moved. This section of the Traffic bylaw is to prevent the on-street storage of vehicles along busy streets.

Strategic Link: This regulation is in place to help control vehicle congestion in residential areas as well as commercial zones across the City.

Key Points

- Vehicles cannot be parked over 24 hours at a time on City streets.
- This is not a new regulation for the City and has historically been enforced on a complaint basis.
- This restriction is in place to control congestion on City streets caused by long-term parked cars.
