Road Resurfacing Work starting on Terminal Avenue

Delays and traffic pattern changes can be expected starting April 16

Summary

Following the utility upgrade work completed in 2017, the road resurfacing of Terminal Avenue from Stewart Avenue to St. George Street will begin on Monday, April 16. Motorists should expect traffic patterns to change throughout construction, and are advised to use care and encouraged to consider alternate routes.

This final phase of the project is scheduled to be complete by end of July 2018.

Strategic Link: This project meets the Asset Management priority in the current Strategic Plan.

Key Points

- During this work, traffic disruptions can be expected.
- Construction signs will be posted and flagpersons will be on duty to assist with the traffic flow. Please exercise
 caution when nearing the construction zone, obey all signage placed for safety, and follow the directions of
 the flagpersons on duty.
- The resurfacing work will be divided into three sections (south to north) and completed by July 2018.
