Ms. DeFehr was appointed Nanaimo's Inaugural Youth Poet Laureate due to her passion for poetry and experience in the literary arts. Ms. DeFehr has participated in many of Nanaimo's poetry initiatives such as the Nanaimo Poetry map and the Poetry in Transit program. She is looking forward to working with other young Nanaimo poets on many wonderful and creative initiatives.
