City accepting applications for 2017 downtown event funding

Deadline for submission is Friday, March 31 at 4:00pm

Summary

The City of Nanaimo is now accepting applications from community organizations seeking financial assistance to support downtown Nanaimo events through the Downtown Event and Revitalization Fund.

Strategic Link: These programs support Cultural Vitality, one of the four pillars of the 2012-2015 Corporate Strategic Plan. As well, they support the 2014-2020 Cultural Plan for a Creative Nanaimo's strategy to support ongoing and stable core funding to non-profit arts and cultural organizations to enable them to leverage funding from other sources.

- The Downtown Event and Revitalization Fund supports events and initiatives that attract residents and visitors to the downtown.
- The deadline for application submission is Friday, March 31, 2017, no later than 4:00 p.m.
