

City of Nanaimo Heritage Register Public Nomination Form

In 1998, the City published an inventory of heritage resources entitled "The Heritage Resources of Nanaimo." Approximately 125 historic buildings were included on this inventory plus 6 historic cemeteries, 15 historic structures, sites and objects, and an assortment of historic landscape features. In 2001 an additional 17 buildings were added to the inventory. On 2002-Oct-07 a modified version of this inventory was adopted by City Council as the City's official Community Heritage Register.
