

**PROPOSED DEFINITIONS FOR LIQUOR USES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
LIQUOR CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE (LCAC)**

Existing	<p><u>Liquor Retail Store</u> – means a retail store licensed under the <i>Liquor Control and Licensing Act</i> for the sale of beer, wine, or other alcoholic beverages.</p>	<p><u>Stakeholders deferred to Liquor Strategy Task Force to develop location criteria.</u></p>
New	<p><u>Lounge</u> – means a limited scale establishment licensed to serve liquor in conjunction with live entertainment and/or dancing as a Liquor-Primary establishment, under the <i>Liquor Control and Licensing Act</i> and amendments thereto.</p> <p><u>Neighbourhood Pub</u> – means an establishment licensed to serve liquor in conjunction with live entertainment and/or dancing as a Liquor-Primary establishment under <i>the Liquor Control and Licensing Act</i> and amendments thereto, and shall offer full lunch and dinner menus complete with hot and cold meals.</p> <p>Add a condition of use regulating size as follows:</p> <p>(Neighbourhood Pub) Shall not exceed a maximum patron occupancy of 175 patrons.</p> <p>(Lounge) Shall not exceed a maximum patron occupancy of 50 patrons.</p>	<p>Spaxman recommended allowing in all downtown zones. <u>Stakeholders agreed.</u></p>
New	<p><u>Nightclub/Cabaret</u> – means an establishment licensed to serve liquor in conjunction with live entertainment and/or dancing as a Liquor-Primary establishment under the <i>Liquor Control and Licensing Act</i> and amendments thereto. In this definition, live entertainment includes forms of adult entertainment, including exotic dancing and stripping.</p>	<p>Spaxman recommended allowing former definition of Liquor-Primary Business 2 in C-24 (Core), C-25 (Fitzwilliam), C-27 (Terminal), C-29 (Harbour Park). <u>Stakeholders recommendation: permit in C-24 (Core), C-27 (Terminal), C-29 (Harbour Park), but not in C-25 (Fitzwilliam).</u></p>
