

BEAUFORT PARK DOG OFF-LEASH AREA

Tucked away in central Nanaimo, Beaufort Dog Park is a partially fenced area with plenty of space for dogs to run and play. Shaded by the many mature trees and having a flat, easily accessible terrain, this off-leash area is perfect for people who want a quiet place to enjoy time with their dogs.

LOCATION AND PARKING

Beaufort's dog off-leash area adjoins the gravel parking area at the end of Chelsea Crescent. (See map on reverse page.)

PARK HOURS

Open all day (observes main park hours) and year round.

FENCING

Partially fenced along two sides.

WATER

None available. Bringing your own is recommended.

OTHER AMENITIES & NOTES

- **Pick-up Bags/Garbage Cans:** There are 2 dispensers and 2 garbage cans, 1 each at the east and west ends of the dog off-leash area. Please deposit all bags into a garbage can.
- **Benches:** Bench in the middle of the dog off-leash area.
- **Shelter:** None.
- **Shade:** Plenty of trees provide ample shade.
- **Terrain:** Flat, grassed with a dirt path that leads through the off-leash area to the on-leash area of Beaufort Park and beyond.
- **Handicapped Accessibility:** This area is wheelchair accessible and easily navigable for those with walking limitations. Parking is available very close to off-leash area.
- **Washroom Facilities:** None available.
- The off-leash area is linked to a greater trail system throughout Beaufort Park that owners and pets can enjoy on-leash.
- As with most of Nanaimo, Beaufort Park has a thriving population of rabbits. It is also used as a thoroughfare for non-dog owners and parents with children.
