

ST. GEORGE RAVINE PARK

DOG OFF-LEASH AREA

St. George Ravine Park has a small flat grassy area at the top of the park that is suitable for neighbourhood off-leash use and smaller dogs.

(Pilot area until April 30, 2012)

LOCATION AND PARKING

Parking for a few cars is available on the road right of way off St. George Street. Walking to this park is encouraged. (See map on reverse page.)

PARK HOURS

Open all day (observes main park hours) and year round.

FENCING

None.

WATER

Bring your own, as there is no fresh water.

OTHER AMENITIES & NOTES

- Pick-up Bags/Garbage Cans: There is a pick-up bag dispenser and garbage bag at the trailhead. Please deposit all bags into a garbage can.
- Fencing: None, but some edges are bermed and surrounded by steep terrain.
- Benches: Can be found in the off-leash area.
- Shelter: None.
- Shade: Open grassy setting
- Terrain: Flat and accessible in off-leash area. Trail to the rest of the park is steeper.
- Handicapped Accessibility: Off-leash area is accessible. Entire park is not universally accessible.
- Washroom Facilities: None.
