SUPPLY LIST WATERCOLOUR PAINTING

Beginner & Intermediate

- Piece of cardboard in thick plastic bag, taped shut or coroplast (the corrugated plastic board that they make signs out of).
- 140 lbs Arches or Winsor Newton paper cold press. The Arches would be medium surface. Can be a sheet or pad. One sheet 22" x 30" will be plenty.
- HB pencil
- White vinyl eraser
- Old toothbrush
- Plastic card (e.g. hotel key, credit card etc.) cut in half
- Brushes
 - 3/4 inch flat
 - #6 or 8 round
 - Fine round (3 or 2) or a rigger
 - Bring what brushes you have
- Paints: bare minimum
 - Alizarin crimson
 - Cobalt blue or ultramarine blue
 - Cadmium or another warm yellow
 - A brown like burnt sienna or burnt umber
- Optional: A cadmium red or phalo blue (e.g. Windsor blue or Prussian blue)
- Bring what you have, remember dried tubes are still good.
- Pallet: a covered one would be nice, but can get away with a white plate.
- Hair dryer
- Masking tape 1/2"
- Kleenex, paper towel or old towel
- Water container
