September 18th- Everyone in the pool! Nanaimo's Aquatic Centre will reopen Monday, September 21st after the centre's annual maintenance shut down. The facility is now at its original 2001 opening status as far as system operations and water quality. During the shutdown all of the water was drained and the systems flushed to allow for refurbishing, cleaning, replacing of filters, and minor repairs throughout the facility.

The public is invited to the centre for regularly scheduled programs and drop in swims. The first special event planned is the 'Welcome Back to Fall' swim on Friday, September 25th from 6:30pm to 8:30pm. Lessons at the Nanaimo Aquatic Centre begin in the middle of October, so if you haven't already booked your next session now is the time.
