June 24th, 2010– The City of Nanaimo and the Nanaimo Art Gallery are pleased to announce the installation of nine temporary public art pieces in Nanaimo’s parks. Eight pieces will be located in the Maffeo Sutton Park Spirit Square and one piece will be located in McGregor Park (across from the Port Theatre).

Several local artists have collaborated on the diverse display, which will help to animate the parks and create new landmarks along the Harbourfront Walkway this summer. The pieces will be officially on display from July 1st, 2010 through October 2010, at which time they will be auctioned off to the public by the Nanaimo Art Gallery.
