DOG OFF-LEASH PARKS

The City of Nanaimo, Parks Recreation and Culture Commission is hosting a public open house regarding dog off-leash parks. Dog off-leash parks are city owned and designated locations where owners can let dogs run free and play without a leash. Nanaimo currently has three dog off leash parks with varying characteristics and amenities (Beban Park, Cable Bay Trail and Westwood Park power lines).
