CITY OF NANAIMO

BYLAW NO. 5207

A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE "BEBAN HOUSE" A MUNICIPALITY HERITAGE SITE

WHEREAS the Council may, by Bylaw, pursuant to Section 1022 of the *Municipal Act*, "designate real property in whole or in part as protected under this section if the local government considers that the property has heritage value or heritage character" and;

WHEREAS the City of Nanaimo has identified "Beban House" (located at 2290 Bowen Road), which is owned by the City of Nanaimo, as a building deserving of municipal heritage designation;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, hereby designates "Beban House" a heritage building.

Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "MUNICIPAL HERITAGE SITE DESIGNATION BYLAW 1996 NO. 5207".

Interpretation

2. In this Bylaw:

"BEBAN HOUSE" means the 1930s two story wood structure with the legal

description of: Lot 1, Section 18-20, Range 7, Plan 27441

and Civic address of 2290 Bowen Road.

"HERITAGE DESIGNATION" means the exterior structure of "Beban House" as

described in Section 1022 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>. The land upon which the building is located is not considered to be of heritage significance, and does not comprise a portion of the municipal heritage site designated by this bylaw.
