BYLAW NO. 7207

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR HIGHWAY CLOSURE AND DEDICATION REMOVAL

WHEREAS Council has deemed it expedient to stop up and close to traffic and remove highway dedication of Tranquille Road adjacent to 5302 Dewar Road for the purpose of disposing of the land to the adjacent landowner for consolidation with the adjacent landowner's lands; and.

WHEREAS all lands and premises immediately adjoining, and in the vicinity of the highway that is stopped up and closed are adequately serviced by well-established highways giving convenient access to all such premises; and,

WHEREAS pursuant to Sections 40(3) and (4) and Section 94 of the *Community Charter* the City of Nanaimo has published notice of its intention to adopt this Bylaw, has delivered notice to the operators of utilities whose transmission or distribution facilities or work Council considers will be affected, and has provided an opportunity for persons who consider they are affected to make representations to Council.

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Nanaimo, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "ROAD CLOSURE AND DEDICATION REMOVAL FOR TRANQUILLE ROAD ADJACENT TO 5302 DEWAR ROAD BYLAW 2015 NO. 7207".
- 2. That Tranquille Road adjacent to 5302 Dewar Road comprising .205 ha (2,048 m²), more or less shown as "Closed Road" on plan EPP49272 prepared by Brian Henning, B.C.L.S., a reduced copy of which is attached as Schedule A hereto, is hereby closed to all traffic.
- 3. The highway dedication of Tranquille Road adjacent to 5302 Dewar Road referred to in Section 2 is hereby removed.
- 4. His Worship the Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby authorized to execute all the necessary documents as may be required for the due completion of the aforesaid highway closure and dedication removal.


