By rezoning the lands legally described as LOT 9, BLOCK 63, SECTION 1, NANAIMO DISTRICT, AND OF THE BED OF NANAIMO HARBOUR, PLAN 584, (350 Terminal Avenue) to allow Cannabis Retail Store as a site-specific use within the Terminal Avenue (DT4) Zone, as shown on Schedule A.

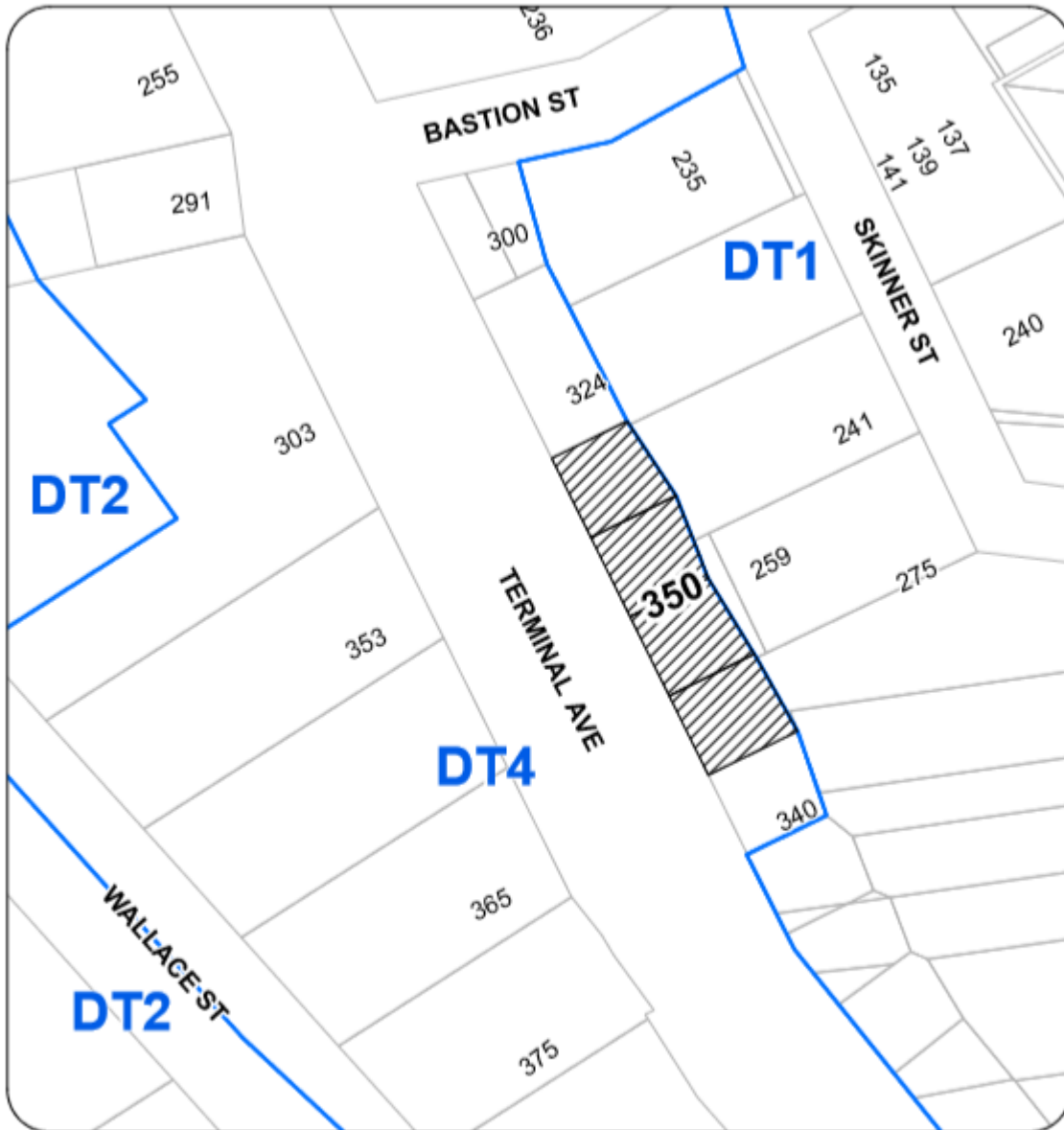
