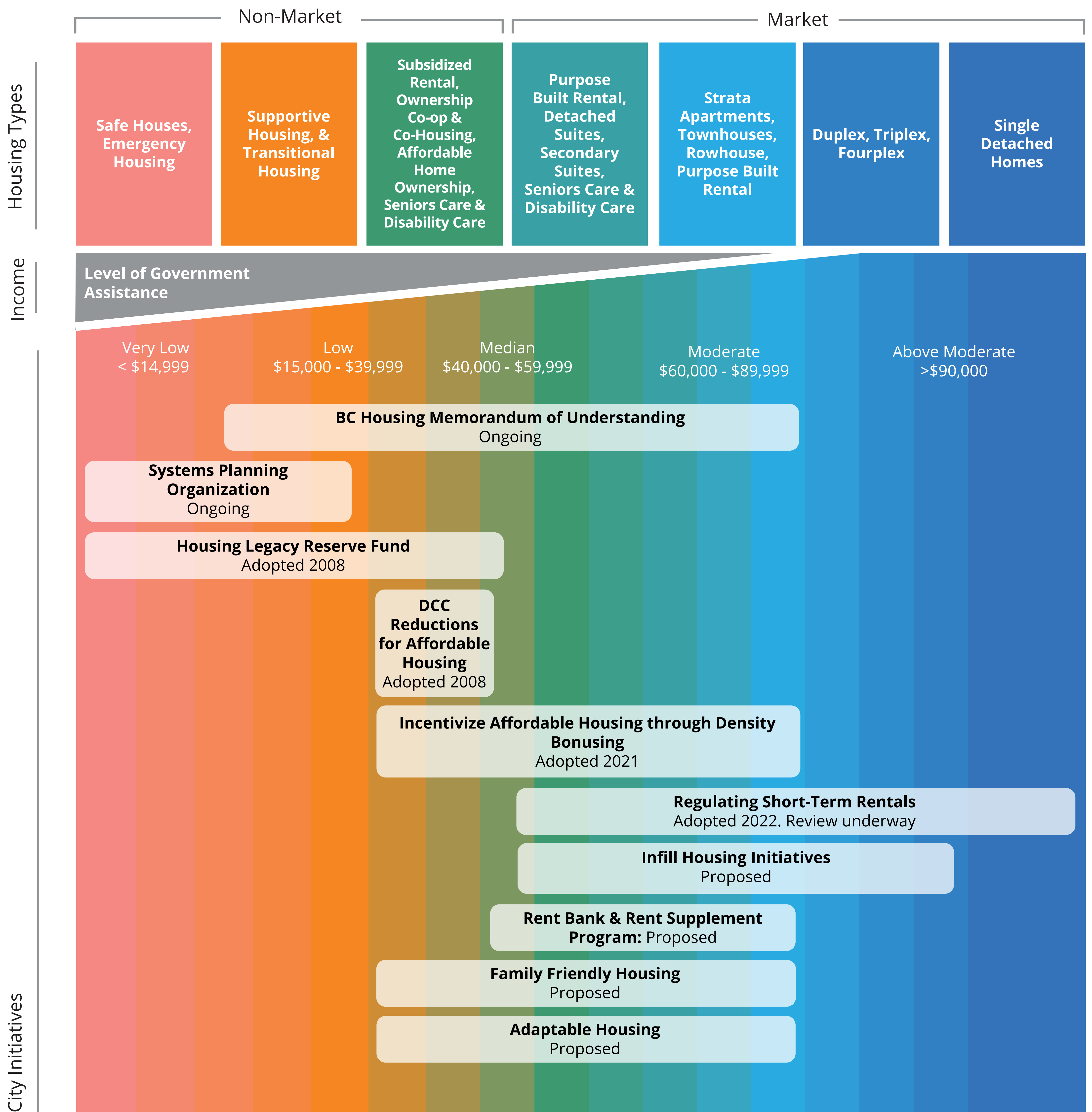


NANAIMO'S HOUSING NETWORK

The Nanaimo housing network shows the range of housing that our community needs, from subsidized emergency and supportive housing, to fourplexes and single detached home ownership. The network showcases a diversity of housing options that support people's changing life circumstances and does not predetermine a pathway or flow from one housing type or tenure to another.

'Non-Market' housing requires government assistance in the form of a subsidy. Whereas, 'Market' housing is not subsidized. A healthy and diverse range of housing options will improve affordability throughout the entire housing network, and will lead to a more vibrant, inclusive, diverse, and well functioning community.
