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City of Nanaimo receives Distinguished Budget Presentation Award

Finance Department recognized by Government Finance Officers Association

Summary

The City of Nanaimo has received the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for the 2014-2018 Financial Plan by the Canada/US Government Finance Officers Association. This is the highest form of recognition in governmental budgeting and represents "best practices" in the field.

To receive this award, applicants must be rated "proficient" in four categories which measure how well the budget serves as: a policy document; a financial plan; an operations guide; and a communications device. There are fourteen mandatory criteria within those categories.

In conjunction with the award, a Certificate of Recognition for Budget Presentation will be presented to the City of Nanaimo Finance Department.

Strategic Link: A complete and informative Financial Plan document is important to support the City's priority of Taking Responsibility.

Key Points

- The award recognizes government bodies who meet nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation.
- This award is the highest recognition in governmental budgeting.
