The City of Nanaimo's Culture and Heritage Commission recognizes outstanding organizations, groups or individuals in the arts, culture & heritage fields in Nanaimo. The public is invited to nominate organizations or individuals for the following award categories: Excellence in Culture; Honour in Culture; Emerging Cultural Leader; and John Thomson Heritage Memorial.

This is your opportunity to recognize people and groups you believe have made a significant contribution to making Nanaimo a culturally vibrant city. Nominations are reviewed by the Culture and Heritage Commission, with recommendations being made to City Council. Recipients are recognized at a celebration at the Port Theatre in April of 2015.

- The Excellence in Culture award is presented to an organization or individual that has achieved regional and/or national recognition in the field of arts and must be recognized as a "Nanaimo Artist," demonstrated excellence in their field, and as being a significant inspiration to others.
- The Honour in Culture award is presented to an individual, group or corporation that is known for their dedication and support of the development of Nanaimo's cultural sector.
- The Emerging Cultural Leader award recognizes up-and-coming, Nanaimo-based cultural leaders. This award targets individuals under 30 years of age who have contributed significantly to the cultural life in Nanaimo.
- The John Thomson Heritage Memorial award honours individuals who demonstrate outstanding heritage service and dedication to the community.
