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# **Council Advisory Committees and Commissions set to resume**

### **Summary**

At its regular meeting held March 2, Nanaimo City Council voted to establish the names and functions of the following 12 Advisory Committees and Commissions:

- Advisory Committee on Environmental Sustainability
- Core Services Review Committee
- Design Advisory Panel
- Grants Advisory Committee
- Nanaimo Culture and Heritage Commission
- Nanaimo Economic Development Corporation Nominating Committee
- Parks and Recreation Commission
- Planning and Transportation Advisory Committee
- Safer Nanaimo Advisory Committee
- Social Planning Advisory Committee
- South Downtown Waterfront Committee
- Youth Advisory Council

In addition, the following committees were dissolved:

- Development Process Review Committee
- Governance Steering Committee

And finally, staff were directed to explore opportunities to create the following two new committees:

- Green/Red Tape Committee
- Intergovernmental Committee
