Key Points

- Council Committees, Boards and Commissions meet to discuss relevant and important issues that affect Nanaimo and its residents.
- Committees and Commissions provide advice to Council pertaining to policy, planning and the provision of services while groups such as the Board of Variance support City governance as required by provincial mandate.
- Generally, the membership term for each of the Committees, Boards and Commissions is a three-year term ending March 31, 2018. This time line may be revised subject to the Core Services Review.
