Parking restrictions being implemented in the Nob Hill area

Resident exempt zones established to ease congestion

Summary

The City of Nanaimo is currently installing new signage to restrict long-term parking in and around the Nob Hill area. The new resident parking zones will allow residents to have more access to on street parking, while maintaining a parking supply for other users. Drivers are reminded to pay attention to new parking restrictions in the Nob Hill area.

Strategic Link: This initiative will enhance parking opportunities for residents of the area while maintaining an on-street supply of parking for visitors.

Key Points

- Due to residents concerns over high on street traffic congestion, the City of Nanaimo is installing signage to restrict long-term parking on City streets in and around the Nob Hill park.
- By modifying the established resident exempt parking restrictions, the City is providing parking for both residents and non residents of the area.
