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SSS Manhao International notifies City of decision to discontinue Hotel project

Summary

In a letter received Thursday, July 9th, SSS Manhao International Tourism Group informed the City of Nanaimo of its intention not to proceed forward with their proposed downtown hotel adjacent to the Vancouver Island Conference Centre.

Key Points

- The City of Nanaimo had been waiting for a reply from SSS Manhao since Council passed a motion June 22 extending the time during which construction on the site could begin, on the condition that a building permit was sought within six months.
- Council agreed to the six-month extension under the condition that SSS Manhao commit \$100,000 towards the improvement of Piper Park and relinquish its Right of First Negotiation for the Vancouver Island Convention Centre.
- With SSS Manhao International's decision not to proceed forward with the hotel project, the terms of the original agreement signed between the City of Nanaimo and SSS Manhao allows the City to purchase the hotel property back for the original sale price of \$565,000.
