Residents of Nanaimo are reminded that feeding wildlife is not permitted in the City. This includes giving food to deer and feral rabbits.

- Feeding wild animals puts them at risk or injury from predators and road traffic.
- Feeding deer can lead to injuries to humans.
- Human food is not suitable for wildlife.
