Process allowing additional recordings of Council meetings underway

Summary

Nanaimo City Council has moved forward with a new procedure which provides residents greater access to meetings held by their elected officials. Council and Committee of the Whole meetings taking place in the City's Service and Resource Centre (SARC) boardroom are now recorded on video. Members of the public wishing to view the meetings can do so by visiting the City's website.

Strategic Link: Taking responsibility to be an excellent municipal government.

Key Points

- The new procedure applies to all Council and Committee of the Whole meetings held in the Service and Resource Centre. Meetings held in the Shaw Auditorium are already recorded.
- Meetings held in the Service and Resource Centre boardroom include budget workshops, orientations and updates. The space is advantageous for extended discussions and close collaboration.
