  to recognize individuals who have made a significant contribution to the culture of our community over their
  lifetime.
- The Honour in Heritage Award is presented to individuals, groups and corporations who demonstrate
  outstanding support, advocacy, promotion or interpretation of Nanaimo's heritage and history. This is a new
  award category for 2018.
