2018 Alternative Approval Process results now available

The City of Nanaimo is pleased to release the results of the Alternative Approval Process (AAP) to borrow funds for the Fire Station #1 Rebuild.

With a total of 783 responses, elector approval to borrow up to \$17 million for the rebuild has been obtained.

Key Points

- With less than 10 per cent of residents responding to the AAP, Council may now choose to adopt the Fire Station #1 Borrowing Bylaw 2018 No. 7257.
- For elector approval to not be obtained, at least 10 per cent (or 6,842) of eligible voters needed to respond to the AAP by the deadline of May 4, 2018.
