Crews Respond to Fire at Tent City

Summary

Shortly after 11:45 pm on Thursday, June 28, Nanaimo Fire Rescue crews responded to a structure fire (tent) at Nanaimo Discontent City at 1 Port Drive. Upon arrival the tent had a small smouldering fire inside where one person was sleeping, they were not injured. The cause of the fire is undetermined, however, witness accounts state it could have been a candle or a lit cigarette.

Strategic Link: The City of Nanaimo is committed to public safety.

Key Points

- One person escapes injuries from fire at Discontent City.
- The public is reminded candles and smoking materials should not be left unattended and to ensure they are properly extinguished.
