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City accepting applications for 2019 Social Planning Grants

Deadline is 4:00 PM on Friday, October 26, 2018

Summary

The City of Nanaimo is now accepting applications for the 2019 Social Planning Grant Program. The program aims to assist organizations in responding to issues of a social nature with initiatives that enhance social cohesion, address the root causes and effects of poverty, contribute to the vitality of our community and foster social inclusion and social equity.

A total of \$85,000 is available under two grant categories: Social Response Grants (\$60,000 available) and Community Vitality Grants (\$25,000 available). Organizations that apply for funding must be based in Nanaimo and/or be proposing a project that primarily serves Nanaimo residents. Eligible organizations include non-profit societies, recognized religious groups and neighbourhood associations recognized by the City of Nanaimo.

The City is seeking applications that address one or more of the following priorities: Social Equity; Community Diversity; Community Wellness and Vibrant Neighbourhoods. More detail on these categories is provided in the Grant Guidelines and Criteria document, which is available along with the application forms on the City of Nanaimo Social Planning website (www.nanaimo.ca > Culture & Environment > Grants > Social Planning Grants). The deadline for submitting an application is 4:00 PM on Friday, October 26, 2018.
