New speed limit for Departure Bay Road at Departure Bay beach

Speed limit reduced to 40 kph for the summer

Summary

The City of Nanaimo is conducting a trial speed limit reduction on Departure Bay Road at Departure Bay Beach between Victoria Day weekend and Thanksgiving weekend. During the summer, Departure Bay beach becomes one of the most popular destinations in the City for families to hang out and cool down. With all the visitors, there is a huge increase in biking and walking activity. In an effort to improve walking and cycling comfort and safety, the City is planning to trial a 40kph speed limit for these busy months. Throughout this trial, the City, ICBC, and the RCMP will work together to host education and enforcement campaigns to continue to support road safety.

Strategic Link: Reducing vehicle speeds on Departure Bay Road will support the City's Strategic Initiatives by encouraging active transportation and by creating more livable communities.
