DEADLINE EXTENDED! Calling all poets! Apply to be Nanaimo's next Poet Laureate

Deadline for applications is Friday, January 17, 2020 (4:00 pm)

Summary

DEADLINE EXTENDED! The City of Nanaimo is calling all poets to apply to be Nanaimo's next Poet Laureate (for a three-year term, February 2020 to January 2023). The purpose of a Poet Laureate is to serve as the "people's poet" and to raise awareness of poetry, the literary arts and the positive impact literature and poetry can have on community life. At the end of the three-year term, each Poet Laureate is given the opportunity to have a poem cast in concrete and added to Nanaimo's Poetry Walk.

Candidates can be nominated by someone else or self-nominated. Selection criteria includes: demonstrated ability to engage and inspire the community; clear and innovative ideas regarding the vision for the position; and ease and skill at presenting/performing work to the public.

The extended deadline for application submission is Friday, January 17, 2020 (4:00 pm).

Strategic Link: The Poet Laureate programs ensure that Nanaimo has a strong and vibrant culture which evolves with a coordinated and collaborative effort leading to greater popularity as a place to visit, live, work and play furthering the goals of "Livability" in the City's Strategic Plan.
