Council approves ten new pieces of temporary public art for 2020

On December 16, 2019, Council approved ten new pieces of public art as part of the 2020 Temporary Outdoor Public Art Program. A total of 36 proposals were received from a variety of artists and teams across Canada in response to a "Call for Artists" issued by the City of Nanaimo's Purchasing Department.
