Raising a flag for reconciliation

Snuneymuxw First Nation flag returns to City Hall

Summary

At 9:30 am this morning, a Snuneymuxw First Nation flag placement ceremony occurred on the steps of City Hall. Returning the flag to its permanent position recognizes the important relationship between the City of Nanaimo and the Snuneymuxw First Nation.

Mayor Krog and Chief Wyse both delivered heartfelt speeches highlighting the efforts being made towards a more positive relationship and how they plan to continue moving forward with respect and open communication.

The Protocol Agreement renewal took place in May 2019, establishing a respectful government-to-government relationship.

Strategic Link: To be a community that is livable, environmentally sustainable and full of opportunity for all generations and walks of life.

- Protocol Agreement Working Group (PAWG), elected officials and media attended this small, intimate ceremony at City Hall.
- Snuneymuxw flag returned to its permanent position at City Hall.
