## City of Nanaimo Call for Applications - Board of Variance

### **Summary**

The City of Nanaimo is currently recruiting one member for the Board of Variance. The Board of Variance (BOV) is an independent body established by "Board of Variance Bylaw No. 7213" under Division 15 of the Local Government Act. The Board consists of five members appointed by City Council. The term of office for the Board of Variance position is a three (3) year term.

The BOV can grant variances to: relax zoning regulations, servicing requirements, and tree protection requirements; extend non-conforming uses; and, reconstruct a non-conforming building.
