



City of Nanaimo Emergency Volunteers called upon to support wildfire evacuees

Summary

City of Nanaimo Emergency Support Services (ESS) volunteers have been called upon by Emergency Management British Columbia (EMBC) to support residents who have evacuated from Lytton and other areas in the interior. The team will provide a virtual "tele" pod service to assist evacuees with registration on the Provincial Emergency Registration system as well as guide them to sources of current information and supports.

The City of Nanaimo ESS team is recognized provincially as a leader in utilizing the online provincial registration system and developed a virtual response model for Covid19. This model is still in use as the team continually explores methods to modernize and streamline their ability to respond.

In addition to supporting other communities, ESS Volunteers provide local support to displaced residents in City emergencies when applicable and are members of a dedicated team that continually trains and prepares for emergencies.
