New accessible, universal washrooms at Neck Point Park now open

Summary

Visitors to the City of Nanaimo's Neck Point Park will notice a new building has sprouted up. A universal washroom facility is now open. The new facility is completely accessible and features two separate universal washrooms and two outdoor changing spaces with showers.

The building is located in the parking lot of the park and fits in well with the natural setting, featuring a green roof system.

A new hard surface path and landscaping complete the project.

Key Points

- A universal washroom is a washroom that is accessible to everyone. The non-gendered space has a variety
 of different options for people with disabilities, including wheelchair users, visually impaired individuals, and
 those who are unsteady on their feet.
- Staff plan to investigate and improve accessibility features within the park by adding a beach access mat to Finn beach in the future.
- The washroom is in a handy location for those needing to make an accessible stop when driving in the Hammond Bay area.
- The total budget for the washroom project is \$510,000.
