# 2025 water main flushing program begins March 2

# **Summary**

Nanaimo's Engineering and Public Works department will be flushing drinking water mains starting on March 2, 2025. Flushing will take place in selected areas this year. While this program is underway, water users may see short periods of low pressure and water may be discoloured. Water discolouration during the flushing program is temporary and is not a health hazard.

Strategic Link: Flushing of the City's water mains supports cost effective service delivery.

## **Key Points**

- City crews will flush select water distribution mains. Clean drinking water is flushed at a high velocity through water mains to ensure that all piping is refreshed and any minor sediment within the pipes is removed.
- If water users notice a change in water appearance such as discolouration, they can clear their water lines by running cold water until it runs clear. Any discolouration in water during the flushing program is temporary and not a health hazard.

### **Quick Facts**

 Running cold water to clear any discolouration instead of hot water reduces energy usage. It also avoids trapping sediment in your hot water tank.
