



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Howard Avenue & Ninth Street - Road Works

August 13, 2026

Copcan Norland, on behalf of the City of Nanaimo, will soon commence construction on the street upgrade project on Howard Avenue and Ninth Street. This work involves localized widening of the existing road pavement to address road safety concerns resulting from the narrowness of the existing 90 degree bend in the road.

To assist with the localized widening of the existing road, a permanent road closure will be in operation at the top of Howard Avenue. The local BC Transit bus service #6 will be diverted via Weber Street and Bruce Avenue. Three bus stops will be affected by the road closure and buses will be unable to pick up passengers at the following stops:~ outside 997 Howard (southbound), and outside 530 9th St (westbound) and outside 507 9th St (eastbound). Access to all local residential properties shall be maintained at all times. However, some residents will have to take an alternative route to access their property.

Typical work hours will be Monday to Thursday, 7am - 7pm. Construction signs will be posted and flag persons are on duty to assist with the traffic flow. Please exercise caution, obey all signage placed for your safety, and follow the directions of the flag persons on duty. We ask local residents to please help us communicate these temporary impacts to your visitors and delivery drivers. To avoid the construction works use Eighth Street and Bruce Avenue.
