JOB SUMMARY

Under the general supervision of the applicable supervisor, the incumbent operates backhoes, front end loaders, and excavators involved in the construction and maintenance of roads and underground utilities.

TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Carries out the construction and maintenance of roads and underground utilities and all related appurtenances.
- 2. Operates equipment in an organized, efficient, and proper manner according to all relevant legislation, policies, and procedures.
- 3. Excavates burial plots at the cemetery.
- 4. Maintains and services equipment to a level necessary for daily operational requirements.
- 5. Ensures that all pre-excavation reports have been completed and are current prior to commencing any excavation at any location.
- 6. Performs snow and ice control as required.
- 7. Performs other duties as required.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Thorough knowledge of diesel engines and hydraulic systems.

Thorough knowledge of the *Gas Safety Act* as it applies to excavation procedures and requirements.

Knowledge of WorkSafe BC regulations as they pertain to excavations.

Ability to comprehend and carry out written and oral instructions.

Thorough knowledge of excavation techniques, hazards, and job site traffic flows in order to minimize the risk of injury and damage.

Ability to review and comprehend applicable construction plans and sketches.

Ability to communicate with courtesy and tact in order to obtain and/or distribute routine data or information to internal and external customers. This may involve the ability to probe for information and clarification.

Work may involve lifting of heavy and/or awkward objects and/or maneuvering of heavy equipment, and/or climbing structures. Core work activities typically require a high level of activity.

MINIMUM TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

Completion of Grade 12, plus completion of equipment operation training.

Minimum of 2 years of experience in equipment operation and maintenance.

Or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Possession of a valid Class 3 BC Driver's Licence with air endorsement.
