Position Overview

The City of Nanaimo is seeking a permanent full-time Urban Forester. Under the general direction of the Manager, Engineering & Environment, the incumbent is responsible for the implementation of the City's Tree Management and Protection Bylaw and assists the City's Urban Forestry Coordinator with the implementation of the City's Urban Forestry Strategy. Independent action and judgment is required to accomplish the City's urban forestry goals, objectives, and bylaws. Complex issues or matters of significant impact are referred to the Manager.

Qualifications

Applicants must have a Diploma in Horticulture, Forestry, Urban Forestry, Arboriculture or Landscape Architecture from a recognized college or university, International Society of Arboriculture (I.S.A.) Certified Arborist (requires a minimum of 3 years' arboriculture experience) and certified Tree Risk Assessor certification.

A valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence is required for this position.

This is a unionized position. \$38.80 per hour - after Probation (Jan 2020 Rate), based on a 35 hour work week. A comprehensive benefit package is included. The wage level for this position is subject to confirmation under a union/management jointly negotiated job evaluation plan.
