Under the supervision of the Arena Maintenance Supervisor, the Arena Maintenance Worker performs ice resurfacing, monitors the Arena's physical plant, maintains building security, carries out janitorial maintenance and handyman duties, and assists the public in their use of the facilities.

Applicants will have completed Grade 12, and have the following qualifications:

- Building Service Worker – Level 1
- 5th Class Power Engineers Refrigeration Certificate
- Minimum 6 months' related experience
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check

These are unionized positions, \$32.89 - \$34.62 per hour (Jan 2022 Rate). Shift work will be involved, including evenings and weekends. There are no guaranteed hours associated with these positions.
