Lifeguard Instructors carry out lifeguarding/instructional duties and are responsible for the supervision and control of activities, safety standards, and cleanliness of aquatic facilities.

Applicants will have completed Grade 10, and have the following qualifications:

- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification
- C.P.R. "C" Certification
- National Lifeguard Certification (Pool Option)
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check

These are unionized positions, starting at \$20.93 per hour. There are no guaranteed hours associated with these positions. Extensive weekend and evening work may be required in addition to weekday shifts.
