2018 Priorities

About Public Works

Public Works is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the City's underground and above ground infrastructure. We are also responsible for providing services to the City such as garbage, organics and recycling collection. Providing vehicles and equipment is also a function of Public Works through Fleet Services.

The four main sections of Public works are:

- Transportation Roads and Traffic Operations
- Utilities Water and Wastewater Operations
- Sanitation, Recycling and Administration
- Fleet Operations

Public Works sections work as a team to ensure systems and services in each area of responsibility are well maintained and provide efficient reliable and safe service delivery. Public Works also responds to emergencies and is in essence the fourth emergency responder.
