Position Overview

The City of Nanaimo is seeking a permanent full-time Water Treatment Plant Operator. Under the direction of the Water Resources Manager, the incumbent performs highly skilled operational and maintenance work in a complex ultra filtration membrane plant. Work involves making independent decisions and performing operational and maintenance duties in order to maintain water quality that meets or exceeds all compliance criteria outlined in the City's Operating Permit and Provincial and/or Canadian Drinking Water Legislation. The position is responsible and accountable for the safe and efficient operation of the City's water treatment system ensuring the production and delivery of safe, potable drinking water.

Qualifications

Applicants must have completed Grade 12 and have a diploma from a recognized technical institute in Water Quality Technology. Possession of a Level III EOCP Water Treatment Certificate or eligibility in British Columbia for the same is required, plus 1 year of experience in operating at Level III water treatment plant operations. Applicants must have a Chlorine Handler Certificate and a valid Class 5 B.C. Driver's Licence.
