Under the general direction of the Manager of Transportation, the incumbent is responsible for using a holistic approach to plan and market active and sustainable transportation throughout the City and will develop, coordinate and execute active and sustainable transportation education, marketing, planning and implementation initiatives. The Coordinator will liaise with stakeholders and community groups and will gather data to guide and support initiatives and plan capital investments.

## Qualifications

Applicants must have a university degree in Engineering, Planning or a related field and a minimum of 3 years' related experience in Active and Sustainable Transportation Planning, Design, Implementation, and Education, with demonstrated experience in delivery of an active and sustainable transportation plan. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. A membership or eligibility for membership in an applicable professional designation is required as well as a valid Class 5 B.C. Driver's Licence.
