The 2024 – 2028 Provisional Financial Plan (provisional budget) has passed first three readings and will go for adoption by Council in January 2024. It integrates the six key focus areas of Council's Strategic Framework as the City works towards building a stronger, more sustainable and more resilient community.

HOW WILL THE 2024 PROVISIONAL BUDGET AFFECT ME?

Total projected revenues for 2024 are \$250.5 million with 62.0% coming from property taxes and 23.1% from user fees. The amount of municipal taxes you pay depends on your property type and your property's assessed value.

The City's provisional budget projects a 8.0% increase in taxes on the average home in the City which includes 1.0% for asset management.




