Common Internet Scams

Phishing

• Poses as a legitimate company

Business Email Compromise (BEC)

• Compromises official business emails accounts to conduct unauthorized fund transfers

URL Hustle

• Tricks into paying a renewal fee claiming URL will expire soon

Malware

Damages or disables computer





Avoid Internet Scams

Don'ts

- Don't click on links, download files or open attachments from unknown senders
- Don't trust based on looks
- Don't share personal or financial information through email
- Don't click on pop-ups

Do's

- Do protect your computer with firewalls, spam filters, anti-virus, and anti-spyware software
- Do pay attention to URLs
- Do pay attention to spelling and grammar
- Do check online accounts and bank statements regularly



Ransomware Attack

Ransomware generally restricts access to the data on infected machines until a ransom is paid

Ransomware attacks can cost smaller companies over \$700,000 per incident – through downtime and reputational harm

Over half of all victims who pay do not recover their files



Data Breach

- A data breach is a security incident in which sensitive or confidential data is copied and stolen
- Stolen data can be used in a variety of harmful ways
- As of November, 2018, both large and small businesses are required to report serious breaches or face fines



How To Protect Your Business

- Get Cybersecurity Insurance
- Implement a password strategy
- Use off-site data back-up
- Speak with an IT Expert
- Focus on the people inside your company


